Masking

 District recommendations on masking will be in accordance with the latest CDC and MDH guidance for schools.

Screening testing

• The district will have free testing kits available to students who may be symptomatic or have a known exposure.

Student Vaccines

Vaccination of eligible students is strongly recommended.

Handwashing and respiratory etiquette

- Routines of hand hygiene will be taught and built into the daily schedule.
- Proper respiratory etiquette will be used (covering coughs and sneezes).
- Hand sanitizer will be available at several locations throughout the building.

Staying home when sick and getting tested

- Students and staff should stay home when sick.
- Students and staff should get tested if experiencing symptoms of COVID-19.
- The school will use the MDH and CDC guidance when determining when to keep students and staff home.

Contact tracing in combination with isolation and quarantine

 Positive case contact tracing will take place as recommended in MDE and MDH guidance for schools. Isolation and quarantining will be based on current MDE, MDH, and CDC guidelines.
